I write this letter to wish you all a Happy Feast of the Sacred Heart of Jesus and to assure you that I beseech His divine Heart to continue to bless every family that lives His spirituality by spreading His devotion according to the charism that the Holy Spirit gave to Mother Clelia, our dearest Mother Foundress.

In addition, I want to ask for your prayers for the 18th General Chapter of the Apostles of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, to be held in Rocca di Papa, Italy, from July 4-30, 2022. The General Government, after studying the theme "Charismatic Family" during the last six years, realized that it would be difficult for the Congregation to constitute such a Family without having other officially existing branches in addition to that of the Religious sisters. Therefore, it was decided to present to the Chapter Assembly the request for canonical recognition of the GFASC Group as a Lay Group, linked to the Institute, by approving the Statute of the Association of the Lay Faithful - GFASC at the international level.

Obviously, constituting a Charismatic Family will require a further step, which would be the existence of other groups recognized by the Institute worldwide; but at present we only have GFASC.

Therefore, I ask for your prayers for this moment so significant and important for the history of the Congregation and for you, so that everything will work to the honor and glory of the Sacred Heart of Jesus and together, as Apostles and Families, we can witness to the fruitfulness and relevance of Clelia Merloni's charism.

I embrace you with affection as I remain united with each family with my prayer!

May the Sacred Heart and Mother Clelia continue to bless and illumine the vocation and mission of GFASC.

THE APOSTLES OF THE SACRED HEART OF JESUS

The Institute of the Apostles of the Sacred Heart of Jesus was founded in Viareggio, Italy, in 1894, by Blessed Clelia Merloni (1861-1930).

Following their motto from St. Paul, "The Love of Christ Impels Us," the sisters serve in the areas of education, health care, and social services. In this, they continue Mother Clelia's dream to "bring a ray of the tenderness of the love of Jesus' Heart to all people." This was a dream of faith and hope that has been accomplished admirably, embracing the entire world.

From the foundation of the Institute, Clelia Merloni never put geographical limits on the service her Apostles would offer for the Reign of God. The Institute grew in number and geographical presence. Today, the Apostles serve in 14 countries: Italy, USA, Brazil, Mozambique, Haiti, Portugal, Chile, Argentina, Paraguay, Uruguay, Albania, Benin, Switzerland, and Ireland.

Clelia realized very early that if she had followed her father's footsteps in a brilliant career her life would never have been fulfilled. Intelligent, talented, and enthusiastic, she generously responded to God's call and chose the consecrated life.

To accomplish God's will and to lead the sisters, Mother Clelia had to face painful trials, undergo profound humiliations, and bear unspeakable suffering for many years. She lived generously and humbly, accepting the daily sacrifices and forgiving those who were the cause of her suffering.

Mother Clelia died in Rome on November 21, 1930. She was buried in the cemetery Campo Verano. In 1945 her body was exhumed and found intact and was transferred to the Generalate chapel.

On January 27, 2018, the Holy Father signed the decree recognizing a miracle, thus completing the process of Beatification. The Rite of Beatification was celebrated on November 3, 2018, in the Basilica of St. John Lateran in Rome.
