## SISTER CATHERINE SEDGEMAN, ASCJ

Sr. Catherine Sedgeman (Catherine Sedgeman) died peacefully on August 1, 2025 at St. Raphael Hospital in New Haven, CT. She was 83 years old and professed as an Apostle of the Sacred Heart of Jesus for 64 years. Sr. Catherine, daughter of the late William and Helen (Herlihy) Sedgeman was born on November 25, 1941, in the Bronx, NY. Sr. Catherine entered the Apostles of the Sacred Heart of Jesus on February 11, 1959 in Hamden, CT. She professed First Vows on August 23, 1961 and Perpetual Vows on August 22, 1966 in Hamden, CT.

Sr. Catherine ministered at Sacred Heart Manor in Hamden, CT for 13 years, and then retired to Sacred Heart Manor in 2012. After suffering some serious health setbacks, Sr. Catherine lived at Elim Park in Cheshire, CT for the last years of her life, where she faithfully continued her ministry of prayer and evangelization as an Apostle. She will lovingly be remembered for her quick wit, creativity and compassion.
